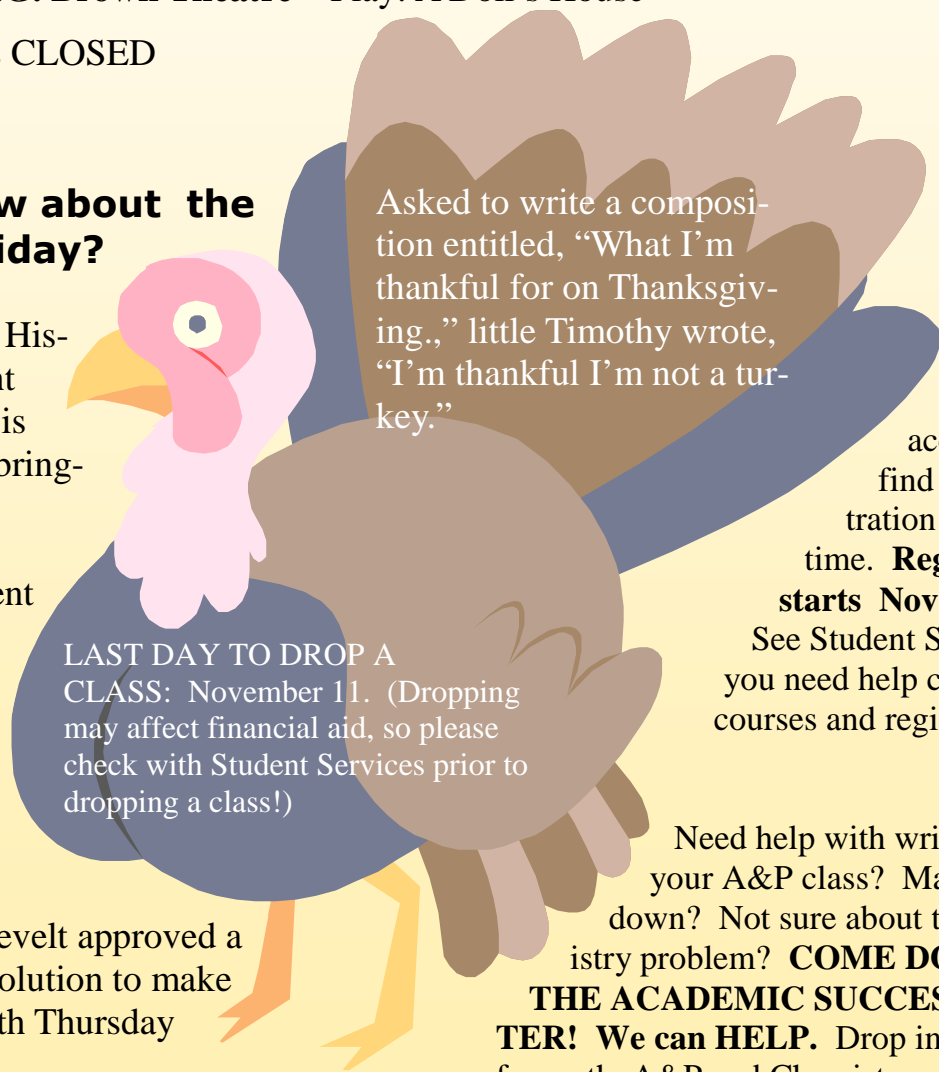
What do you know about the Thanksgiving holiday?

On Oct. 3, 1863, President Lincoln issued the first national Thanksgiving Proclamation setting apart the last Thursday in November as the day to be observed.

In 1941, President Roosevelt approved a Congressional Joint Resolution to make Thanksgiving Day the 4th Thursday of November.
